
I know you're grateful for the opportunity to teach art, inspire students and create art each day. BUT, you wish your days were a little less chaotic and a little more zen.


























Start with your head and body shapes glued on the paper.




Draw a large, backward "C" shape around the top right corner of the head for the ear. Add a few lines inside the ear.




Add an oval for the eye in the top left corner, then add a triangular tusk near the middle of the head, extending outside.



For the trunk, draw a curved line toward the bottom of the paper. Draw an oval at the bottom. Connect back up to the head and add lines inside.



Draw a triangular tail from the top right corner of the body. Add a few lines at the end of the tail.



Add a line in the center of the body to separate the legs. Add a few bumpy lines for toes at the bottom of the body.
